Trish O'Neill was inspired to make honey products to try and ease her skin allergies. After many years of research, and much trial and error, she still struggled to source a product that was suitable for her own skin.

After experimenting with beeswax and honey, she created organic alternative products that are gentle and nourishing for the skin. Trish quickly realised there was a gap in the market for these types of products and started production at her home in Dunhill, Co Waterford in 2015.

From there her business grew and Trish recently moved into a new and larger premise at Dunhill Ecopark to allow the company to expand further.

Trish, who is a third generation beekeeper, has developed a unique, certified organic skincare range including facial balm, body balm, luxurious hand creams and more.

The core ingredients for each product are beeswax and honey. All of these products are handmade in Ireland and are available in selected stores and online.

Trish enjoys the community aspect of ACORNS and says the programme has helped her to drive forward with the business. The community has been – and still is – an important and influential part of her business, especially considering that this is her first entrepreneurial venture.

One of the highlights of 2020 for Trish was receiving silver in the UK based FreeFrom Skincare Awards for her Body Balm with Beeswax. Trish has also recently started exporting products to the UK and Hong Kong, and she plans to export to more countries soon.

Other plans for the future include hiring two freelancers and unveiling a new range of products later this year.
