Allwoman was set up in 2016 when Gerardine won the TESS/LIT Entrepreneur Award, followed later with the Social Entrepreneur Award in 2017, awarded by the Regional Network North Tipperary becoming one of three finalists in the Network Ireland Awards that year.

Having listened to many clients concerns around product and treatment suitability and the enduring side effects of Chemotherapy and Radiation Therapy treatment, Gerardine recognised a need for non toxic products, and that using the right products would have a dramatic and positive impact on a patient's skin, leading to better outcomes while maintaining the skin's integrity.

She created a service that proudly is the first of its kind in Ireland and endorsed by many organisations, while attending many of their annual events, e.g. Irish Cancer Society, the Irish Lung Cancer Committee along with many others. She is very proud of Allwoman's achievements and what it means to those living with and beyond cancer.

Cancer patients have been at the centre of Allwoman for the past 8 years, and early next year in 2025 will see the on-boarding of menopausal women and expectant mums to their product offering.
